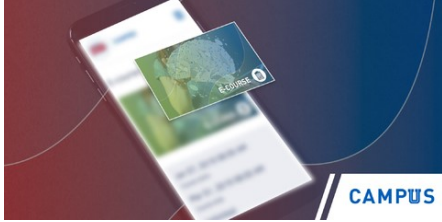
January **volunteer of the month**
