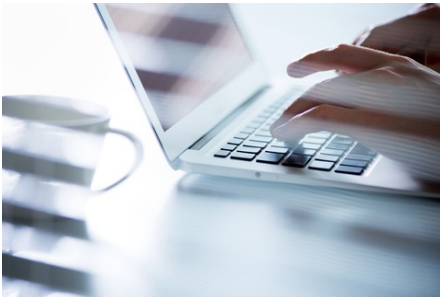

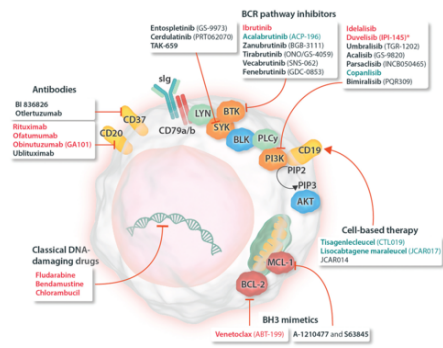
Have you visited **the EHA Campus?**
