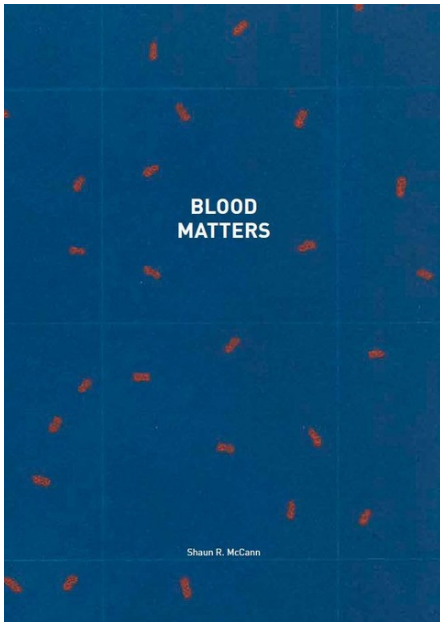
HemAffairs at EHA24: Understand and debate policy and regulatory challenges

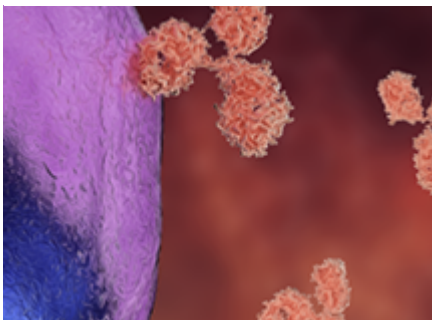
Meet our volunteer of the month
