On September 26-27, 2019, over 175 HARMONY partners came together at the 4th General Assembly in Florence to discuss the second wave of HARMONY research projects. The HARMONY Big Data Platform is one of the largest hematology data platform in the world. Scientists can use this unique resource to characterize the molecular landscape of hematologic malignancies, understand their pathophysiology, and identify novel drug targets.

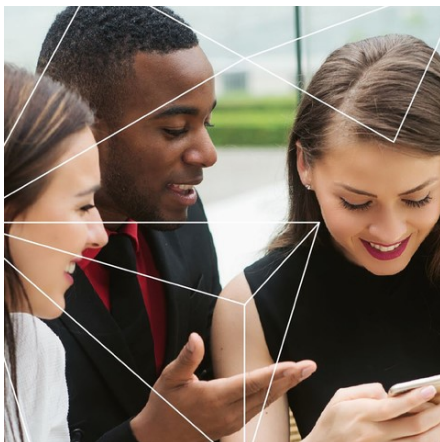
### COST Action 'EuNet-INNOCHRON'
